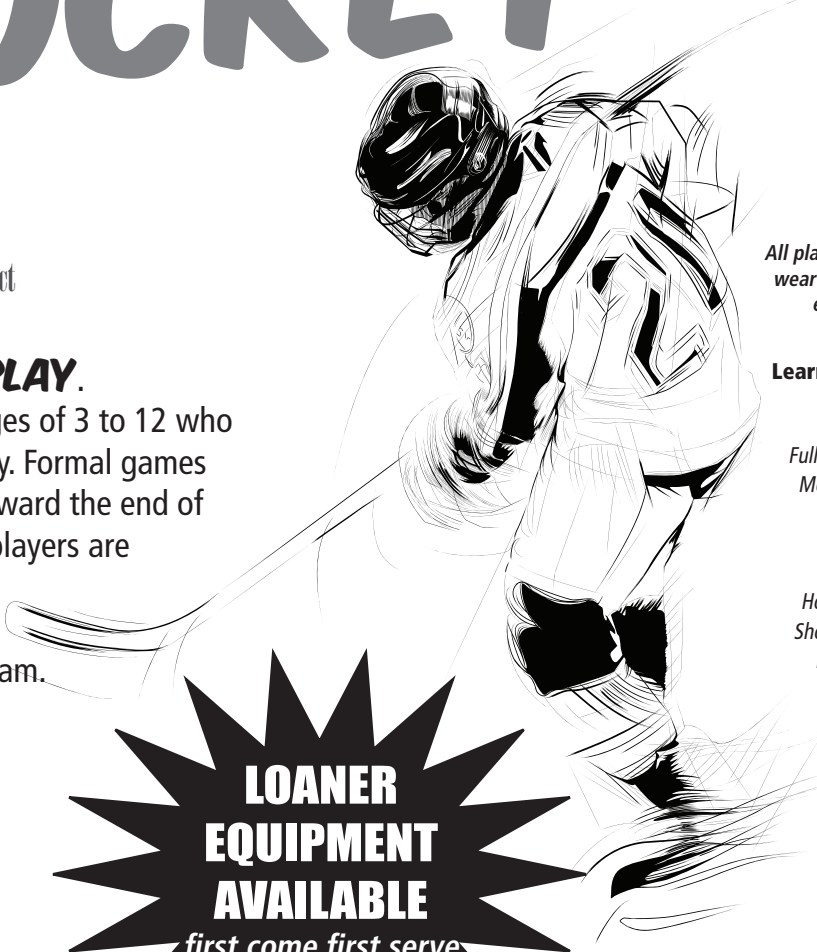

LEARN-TO-SKATE/LEARN-TO-PLAY.

This program is for boys and girls from the ages of 3 to 12 who wish to learn the basics of skating and hockey. Formal games are not played, but scrimmages may occur toward the end of the session. Upon demonstrated proficiency players are encouraged to move up to mini-mites (ages 7 and under) or to lower house (ages 8-12) or to the girls development program.

Cost of the program is \$55 for in-district and \$65 for out-of-district.
